Every 2 Months Inspect & Clean

Pet hair, dust and debris can build up on the rear intake screen and restrict airflow. Keeping the screen clean helps ensure safe operation and best heating performance.

EASY WAY TO CLEAN – BLOW AIR INTO FRONT

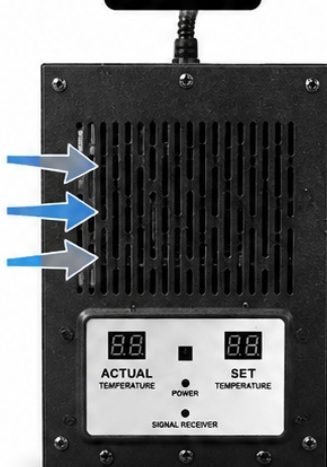
Using compressed air or air duster,

Air will flow through
the unit and push debris
out the rear screen.

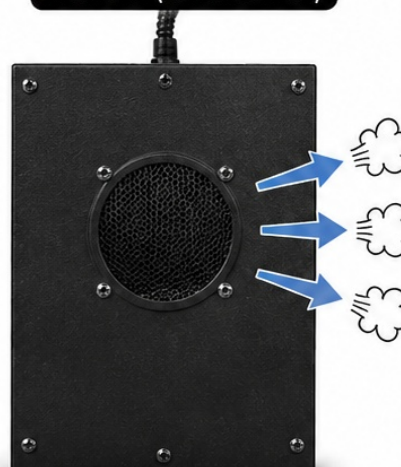


Use compressed

REAR VIEW (FOR REFERENCE)



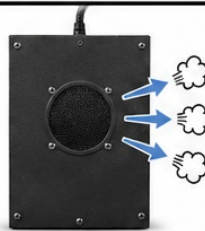
REAR INTAKE SCREEN

GROUND FAULT CIRCUIT REQUIRED

Always plug heater into a properly grounded
GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) outlet or circuit.
